

## General notes

Starting the fourth week in October 2018, Cb Defense customers will receive an automatic upgrade to the Cb Defense Management Console. This document describes usability and performance improvements and bug fixes in the October release.

## Features

### Dashboard widgets

Due to customer feedback, we've introduced two new dashboard widgets to help you easily locate the loudest devices and applications in your environment.

1. Click **Configure dashboard**.
2. Add your preferred widgets and click **Save Configuration**.
3. Filter results by time frame and policy, and filter based on alert threshold level.
4. Click on any of the URLs displayed in the widgets to go to the **Alerts page** within the selected context.

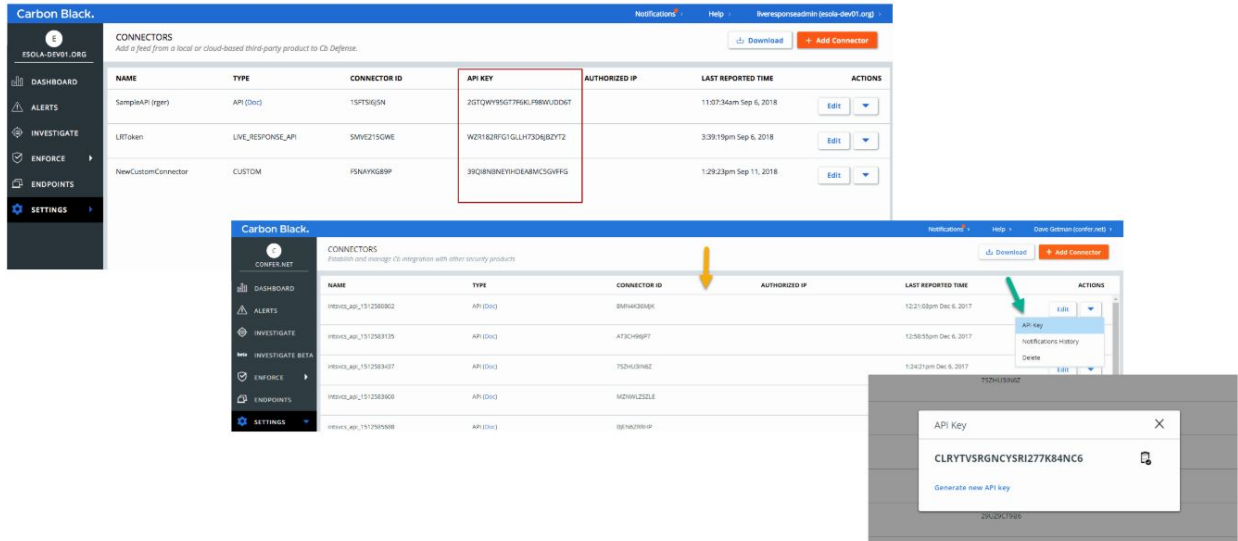

## Protected connector API keys

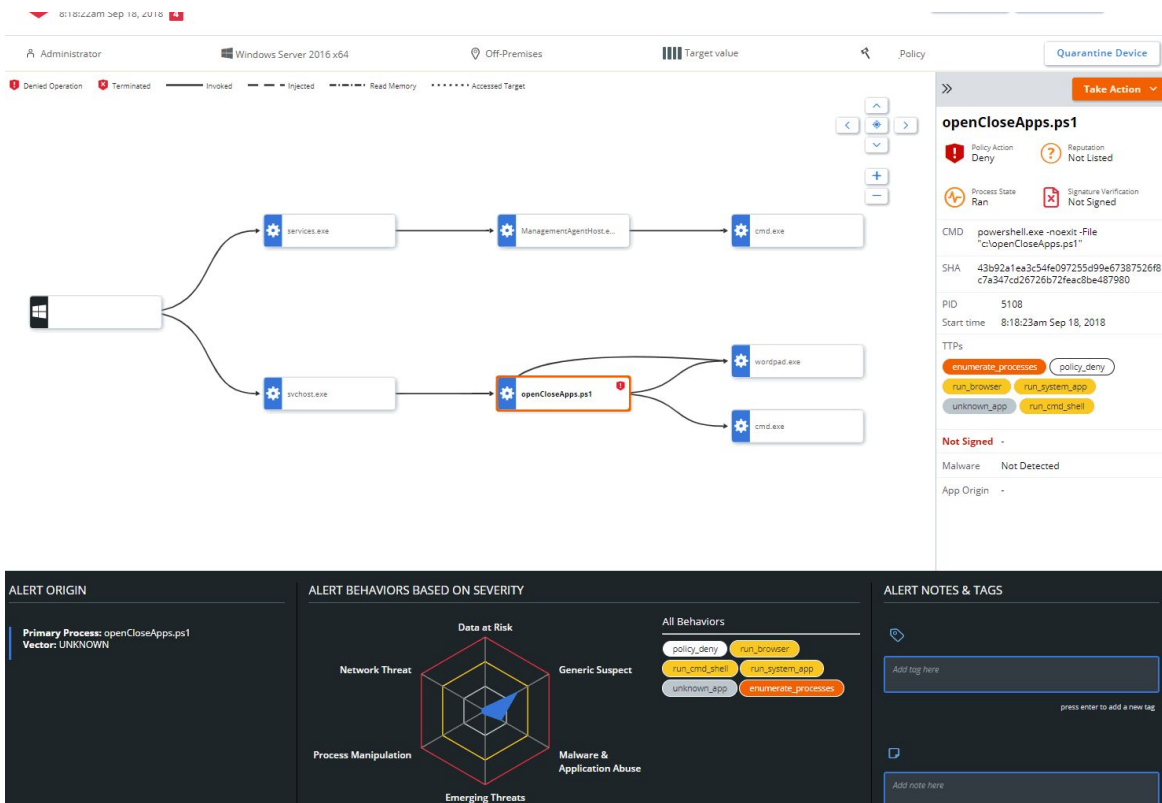
Connectors are now secured by hiding the API Key from view and only revealing the key to users who have permission to view that particular connector type.

## Alert Triage visual update

The **Alert Triage** page is updated. The nodes and the side panel are redesigned based off user feedback.



## Usability Improvements

- Increased pagination limits to 200 (previously capped at 100).
- Renamed the **VMWare CbD Assets** widget to **VMware Virtual Machines**.
- Added the ability to reset your password within a dropdown under your username (top nav).
- Auto-focus on username input box during login to reduce the number of clicks.
- Made the Event timeline panel on the **Investigate** page collapsible.
- Provided the ability to opt-out of release announcement in-product notification types.
- When navigating from the **Alerts** page to the **Investigate** page with an alert selected, you can clear the selection of that alert.
- Added human readable error messages to Live Response.
- Added search and sort capability on the **Settings/Users** page.

## Browsers Supported

- On Windows - Firefox, Chrome, and Edge
- On Mac - Safari, Firefox, and Chrome

Note that IE11 is not a supported browser.

## Issues Resolved in October

ID	Description
DSER-7403	When exporting large data sets from the UI, if the export took longer than 60 seconds, no data was returned.
DSER-10270	When using <b>Live Response</b> , if the browser timed out, unexpected behavior could occur. A workaround for this issue is to disconnect and reconnect the <b>Live Response</b> session. (Fixed via DSER-10275).
DSER-10275	Live Response sessions took up to 30 seconds to initiate.
DSER-8822	Changing the order of Sensor Groups was not working (random).
DSER-8724	Console displayed incorrect policy shown for sensor, despite the sensor receiving the correct policy.
DSER-11166	Dismissing future alerts resulted in alerts not being dismissed.
DSER-10271	Cb Defense browser sessions are automatically disconnected after 60 minutes.

## Known Issues and Caveats

The following section lists known issues in this version of the Cb Defense backend/UI.

ID	Description
DSER-5437	Additional markup is added to events forwarded via the event forwarder.
DSER-8725	Emailed sensor download invite results in <b>Token invalid</b> message when clicking the link.
DSER-9664	Occasionally, clicking the link on an emailed alert notification results in the <b>Alert Triage</b> page not rendering correctly.
DSER-9670	Searching for “threat category:Malware” will occasionally return Non-Malware results.
DSER-9812	Last check in time for a sensor is not updated properly, resulting in out-of-date last check-in times.
DSER-10296	Live Response large file retrievals fail in some cases.
DSER-10352 / DSER-10790	Bulk upload of hash reputation fail in some cases.
DSER-10667	The <b>Applications</b> tab on the <b>Investigate</b> page occasionally shows a NOT_LISTED reputation for files that have a reputation
