General Notes

Starting in the final week of March, existing Cb Defense customers will receive an automatic backend upgrade with a few new features. This document describes the new features.

New Features

RESTful API

Cb Defense now provides a RESTful API interface to the Device and Event datastores, as well as streaming notifications to retrieve Alerts. The new RESTful API are accessible by querying the /integrationServices/v3 URL and provide a consistent interface to the Cb Defense for those that are familiar with RESTful API standards.

Note: Existing connectors and customer developed integrations will continue to work as expected leveraging the /integrationServices/v2 API

New API: Get Events Associated with an Alert

A new API was added to associate events with an alert. If you have an alert ID from the console or from the API, there is now an API that provides access to the details for every event that led to the issuance of that Alert.

Note: Full documentation for this and all other API is available in the product by browsing to Settings -> Connectors, then selecting the "Download" button and "API Specification"

Improved In-Product Notification

The customer managed updates functionality now provides in product notification of best practices for updating devices directly from the Cb Defense Management Console
